Introduction

Congratulations on achieving ICAEW accreditation as an authorised training employer (ATE).

You are now able to use this logo on your business communications related to the recruitment of ICAEW students (including ACA and Higher Apprentices).

This logo allows organisations who are an ICAEW authorised training employer (ATE) to be recognised for their commitment to student training and development. It helps instil confidence because your organisation has been authorised by a world leader in the accountancy and finance profession.

This dedicated logo can only be used by ATE s who currently train ICAEW students or who are in the process of recruitment. If you are not yet authorised as an ATE or no longer train ACA students, you are not entitled to use this logo. If you need to check your status and our terms and conditions of use, please email ate@icaew.com

Use of this logo carries the reputation of ICAEW , so it is important that you use it correctly and consistently. These guidelines will help you ensure that it always looks professional on your communications, in a way that is consistent with our branding.

Authorised training employer logo

CLEAR SPACE

Use the letters ICA from the logo to determine the minimum clear space. As illustrated opposite, use the letters 'ICA' from 'ICAEW' to determine the clear space.

MINIMUM SIZE

The minimum size for the logo is 10mm height.

FORMATS

The logo is available in eps format for printing and png for digital.

BACKGROUND

Always use the logo on a white background. Do not place on coloured or complicated backgrounds where the visibility will be affected.

POSITIONING

If our logo is on a communication with another logo, it should be less prominent.

The preferred position is at the top right or bottom left. It should never be positioned top left.

ANIMATION

When using in a digital environment the logo must not rotate, flash, turn, change dimensions, or move around the screen. It should remain static at all times.

TWO COLOUR

There are two versions of our main logo: black with red dividers, and white with red dividers.

Take care when placing the logo, especially on photographic backgrounds. Select the most appropriate version to ensure that the entire logo, including the red dividers, stands out clearly.

SINGLE COLOUR

Limited use single colour black or white versions are available for monochrome printing only.
